

La Malagueña Sinfónica Presents its Summer Concert at Teatro Manuel España in Mijas

A musical journey through two centuries in a single concert

On **3 July 2026, at 20:30**, **Teatro Manuel España in Mijas** will host the **Summer Concert by La Malagueña Sinfónica**, a musical proposal designed to bring orchestral music closer to all audiences on a summer evening featuring Beethoven, Latin American rhythms, cinematic language and contemporary creation.

This will be the first time La Malagueña Sinfónica performs at Teatro Manuel España, making it a particularly meaningful occasion for the orchestra, as several of its members live or have studied in the area.

The programme will bring together works from very different styles and periods, offering the audience a broad, accessible and contrasting musical journey.

The evening will be led by **Ludwig van Beethoven's Symphony No. 5**, one of the most recognisable works in the history of music. Its famous opening four notes are part of the collective memory and, more than two centuries later, remain one of the great symbols of the expressive power of classical music.

Alongside Beethoven, the orchestra will perform **Danzón No. 2** by Mexican composer **Arturo Márquez**, a score full of energy, colour and Latin American rhythms that has become one of the most frequently performed and widely appreciated orchestral works of the contemporary repertoire.

The programme will also include **Millenium** by **Richard Meyer**, a vibrant and accessible work with references to cinematic language and major contemporary film scores.

One of the most special moments of the concert will come with **First Feeling**, a work by Argentine composer **Leandro Martínez**, which will be performed with the composer himself taking part at the piano. The audience will therefore have the opportunity to enjoy an unusual experience: listening to a contemporary creation in the presence of the person who conceived it and who will share it on stage with the orchestra.

In addition to ticket sales, the concert will include a **Fila 0 support option** for those who are unable to attend but would like to support the project, as well as **La Malagueña Sinfónica merchandise**, available both online and at the theatre.

La Malagueña Sinfónica is a **non-profit cultural association** founded in Málaga with the aim of bringing symphonic music closer to new audiences and creating a meeting place for musicians from diverse backgrounds. The orchestra is sustained through the support of its members, friends and collaborators, as well as ticket sales, merchandise and contributions from those who wish to help the project continue to grow.

With this Summer Concert, La Malagueña Sinfónica reaffirms its commitment to open, diverse and accessible programming, capable of building bridges between the great classical repertoire, Latin American music, audiovisual language and new voices in contemporary musical creation.
