Winemaking requires knowledge, commitment and time. It's a long and slow process, but when terroir and winemaking skills combine, the finished product is worth the wait!

Today it's hard to imagine that Mijas was once a very important viticulture area. Actually one of the few local artisanal wineproducers left is Viña Tamisa. We will first visit the beautiful vineyard, close to the village and talk about the benefits of traditional cultivation and harvesting of grapes in accordance with the principles of organic farming.
