JAFETY COMES FIRST

The Councilor for Festivities, Tamara Vera (PSOE), placed special emphasis on the security device that will surround the Kings on Sunday the 5th.

Therefore, the Local Police and Civil Protection will be present at the parades and there will be an ambulance closing each of the three. In addition, "as in previous occasions and for security reasons, only a maximum of 15 children can ride on each float, who have previously registered at the Citizen Assistance points of the Town Hall and have the authorization of

their parents or guardians. It should be remembered that these children will also be identified with bracelets and be insured" added the councillor.

Vera also called for citizen collaboration to ensure a safe parade and thanked the involvement of volunteers and the different party commissions, as well as the municipal company Mijas Comunicación "for the human and technical deployment that will be carried out" to broadcast the three parades, live to all households.
